Dog Park Rules

- 1. Dogs must be current on all vaccinations/shots.
- 2. Dogs must have a current dog license. Dogs should also wear an owner identification tag at all times.
- 3. Dogs must be leashed when entering and exiting the dog park.
- 4. For safety of your dog(s) and other park visitors, prong (pinch) and spike collars are strictly prohibited. If you use these types of collars, remove them before entering the park.
- No children under the age of 12 are permitted unless accompanied by an adult.
 Children have a tendency to scream and run when excited, which can trigger a dog's prey drive or natural instinct to chase.
- 6. Aggressive dogs are not permitted in the park. Dogs must be removed at the first sign of aggression.
- 7. Female dogs in heat are prohibited from entering the park.
- 8. Dog owners must be in the park and with their dogs at all times.
- 9. All off-leash dogs must be under voice control of their owners. If you cannot control your dog off leash, keep your pet leased at all times.
- 10. Dog owners must keep their leash in hand at all times.
- 11. Please do not bring food into the park if other dogs are in the park. Dog training treats are permitted.
- 12. Owner must clean up dog feces immediately.
- 13. Owner must prevent dog from digging in park.
- 14. Proof of a current rabies vaccination and license is required upon request of a police or animal control officer. Tags may serve as proof.
- 15. Failure to abide by a park rules my result in fines and/or loss of park privileges.

Each handler is legally responsible for his or her dog. Colonial Estates Homeowners Association will assume NO responsibility for any injuries to humans or animals. Therefore, each handler is responsible for supervision of his or her animal. All handlers must remain in the park with their dog at all times.
